

Small and Targeted Grants Awarded

- TG 505-16 Evaluation of runoff from manure treated agricultural plots, Bowling Green State University—\$15,000
- TG 507-16 Dredged Material for Green Infrastructure, Kent State University—\$60,000
- TG 511-16 Evaluating Cross Vanes for Improved Bed Load Interception, Cleveland-Cuyahoga County Port Authority—\$26,250
- TG 513-16 Reclaiming Quarries with Toledo Harbor Dredged Materials, Toledo-Lucas County Port Authority—\$60,000
